Sub: Grant of Conditional Permission to Shri Radhakrishna Toshniwal Ayurved Mahavidyalaya Station Road, Akola, Maharashtra, with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 16 seats in 05 PG courses namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant-02 seats, (ii) Rahana Sharir-02 seats, (iii) Kayachikitsa- 03 seats (iv) Shalya tantra-03 seats, and (v) Rognidan and vikruti Vigyan-06 seats under section 13A/13C of the IMCC Act, 1970, for the academic session 2019-20- reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order no. R.17011/145/2018-EP (IM-1) dated 10.08.2018 related to admission matter for the academic year 2018-19 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic year 2019-20.

- 2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 22-23.03.2019 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate & Post graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs), it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting Conditional Permission for UG (BAMS) and PG course.
- 3. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to grant Conditional Permission to Shri Radhakrishna Toshniwal Ayurved Mahavidyalaya Station Road, Akola, Maharashtra for conducting 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 16 seats in 05 PG courses namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant-02 seats, (ii) Rahana Sharir-02 seats, (iii) Kayachikitsa-03 seats (iv) Shalya tantra-03 seats, and (v) Rognidan and vikruti Vigyan-06 seats for the academic session 2019-20 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to following conditions:

- i. The college shall submit an undertaking in form of affidavit duly notarized within one month from the date of issue of this letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
- ii. The colleges shall submit undertaking in the form of Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers/Hospital Clinical Staff/Consultant in concerned State Boards/Council where the college/hospital is located or Central Registration of the CCIM by 31st December, 2019 as per the decisions conveyed vide letters 22.04.2019 by CCIM and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant/denial of permission for the academic year 2020-21.
- 4. It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate and 15% of post graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 UG seats and 16 seats in 05 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the said Counseling Authority to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- 5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
- 6. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCIM and the Central Government.
- 7. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2019 to get permission for the session 2020-21:
 - (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto* and
 - (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.
- 8. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2020-21.
