



Infrastructures observed by us are as follows -

#### 1) Charts:

There were nearly 57 charts observed by students related to different topics of Agadtantra. E.g. Poison, Injury, Identification, Courts etc.

#### 2) Models:

Various models related to injury, occupational marks were observed by students.
